# **Basis of Preparation**

## **Extractive Sector Transparency Measures Act (ESTMA)**

The 2022 report was prepared in accordance with the ESTMA, which was passed on December 16, 2014 and proclaimed in force on June 1, 2015. The ESTMA requires Canadian extractive companies which are engaged in the commercial development of oil, gas or minerals to report certain types of payments made to a government entity which exceed \$100,000 in the reporting year.

## **Reporting Entity**

In accordance with the ESTMA this report covers payments made by Chevron Canada Limited (CCL), Chevron Canada Resources (CCR) and their controlled subsidiaries which are involved in the commercial development of oil, gas or minerals.

## **Payments**

Payments reported are those made directly to a government entity by CCL, CCR and their controlled subsidiaries on a cash basis net of any refunds received during the reporting year, under the following categories:

- Taxes include all income, profit and production tax payments and exclude consumption, personal income and withholding taxes.
- Royalties paid in cash or in kind.
- Fees include those for licenses, permits, concessions, regulatory charges, rentals or entry.
- Production Entitlement includes cash and in-kind payments made under a production sharing agreement or similar contractual or legislated arrangement.
- Bonus payments include those made during various activities including signing leases, discovering resources or initiating production. For reporting purposes, social payments are included under the “bonus” category.
- Dividends include those paid in lieu of another payment category.
- Payments for infrastructure improvements are those that do not relate primarily to the operational needs of CCL, CCR or their controlled subsidiaries.

Payments are reported at both a project and payee level.

## **Project**

Project is defined as the operational activities that are governed by a single contract, license, lease, concession or similar legal agreement and form the basis for payment liabilities with a government, including agreements that are substantially interconnected. Payments are reported at the project level unless they are not attributable to a specific project, in which case they are reported as an entity level payment.

## **Payee**

A payee includes any Canadian or foreign government; a body established by two or more governments; or any entity that performs a power, duty or function of government.

## **Currency**

Payments are reported in Canadian dollars. Foreign currency payments are converted using the Bank of Canada year end exchange rate.
