Chevron is committed to being a good community partner and neighbour of choice wherever we are in the world. We make investments to help expand economic development and improve social well-being. We align community programs with local community needs and government priorities and plans and, wherever possible, partner with local providers. We focus on programs that contribute to positive, sustainable outcomes in education, economic development, health, community-building, and Aboriginal initiatives.

50 years of history in the Fox Creek area

Chevron Canada's history in the Fox Creek area stretches back more than 50 years. Our roots in the forested foothills region run deep, and include the discovery of the largest wet-gas reservoir in Canada and construction of the largest sour gas plant in the world. We also helped build the town, creating 60 homes and an apartment complex for employees, who soon called the town home and helped build a sense of family and community in and around the area. In November 2017, Chevron announced it was moving into development on a portion of our leaseholdings in the East Kaybob area. It is anticipated this initial development program will comprise approximately 55,000 acres of Chevron's operated position in the Duvernay.

Aboriginal partnerships and programs

We actively consult with Aboriginal communities on whose traditional territory we are working to understand each other's aspirations and concerns. We support a variety of cultural and traditional events, education programs and skills training to ensure that communities realize the benefits of resource development.

Fox Creek Comprehensive Community Plan

Chevron contributed \$150,000 toward a Comprehensive Community Plan for Fox Creek to enable the town to collaborate on a vision for its future development, and to help secure government funding support. The town now has an updated municipal development plan and land use bylaws, as well as a downtown area structure plan that will guide future land use and beautification plans.

Friends of Fox Creek Hospital Society and Fox Creek Hospital

We are helping to improve regional health care by providing training opportunities in Non-Violent Crisis Intervention, Advanced Cardiac Life Support, Emergency Nursing Pediatric Care and Trauma Nurse Core Certification. Chevron Canada has also provided donations to the hospital for equipment purchases and upgrades.

Fox Creek Fire Hall

In times of crisis, we know the men and women of the Fox Creek Fire Department are ready to respond when called. That's why we're proud to support the Fire Hall with contributions toward essential equipment costs.

Fox Creek Food Bank

We appreciate the efforts of the Fox Creek Food Bank to ensure that resources are available to those in need. We're proud to offer financial support to this vital service.


Fox Creek Water Tower

With funding from Chevron Canada, local artists and brothers David and Allan Thomas refreshed the ground-level tank with a 20-by-8-metre mural showcasing the region's spectacular scenery and diverse wildlife. Situated in the heart of Fox Creek's residential area, the water tower was last painted in 1998 by Chevron Canada volunteers as a way of showing their affinity for the community.









Fox Creek Nordic and Trail Club

We understand the importance of investing in projects and programs that help deepen a sense of community. It's why we provide financial support and have donated tools, equipment, and volunteer time to help build and maintain the Fox Creek Nordic and Trail network, located on the west side of Fox Creek. This new trail system significantly bolsters recreation opportunities in the area and can be enjoyed throughout every season.

Recreation and community celebrations

We are proud to support the Fox Creek for the Children Fundraising Society in their efforts to create a world-class playground and outdoor exercise structure for young people in Fox Creek. In additional to funding support, Chevron staff joined in a volunteer event over three days to help construct the elaborate play structure that includes swings, zip lines, a parkour area, as well as seating.

In late 2015, Chevron provided a donation to the 1st Fox Creek Scouts to help finalize kitchen renovations for their building.

And finally, in 2015 the Chevron Facilities Construction team raised almost \$2,000 and collected toys for the Santa's Anonymous hamper program sponsored by the Lion's Club of Fox Creek.

The Banff Centre leadership programs

Chevron Canada has funded scholarships in Leadership at the world-renowned Banff Centre for more than 35 years. Our current support is focused on the Indigenous Leadership program, which provides leaders with the skills and support network necessary to achieve positive change in their communities.

Educational support

We support teaching and learning in the areas of science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM). By sponsoring a variety of school-based initiatives such as science and math supplies, support for local science fairs and field trips for hands-on experiences, we hope to inspire curiosity and critical thinking. We also recognize that great teachers help create great students, so we also support teachers through ongoing professional development opportunities.

Women Building Futures

We are proud to support the work of Women Building Futures, which is helping to break down barriers for Aboriginal women and prepare them for a future career in trades. The organization provides comprehensive support for women through the trades' employment process, from readiness assessments through to on-the-job training.
