### Memorial University of Newfoundland Partnership

Memorial University of Newfoundland joined Chevron's University Partnership Program in 2008. Since then, the company and the university have enjoyed a mutually beneficial relationship. Chevron funds the Chevron Chair in Petroleum Engineering and the Chevron Chair in Reservoir Characterization, and in 2011 committed \$2 million in funding for student scholarships and awards over a ten-year period.
