To Chevron Canada Business Partners:

As we approach one year of responding to the COVID-19 pandemic, I am thankful to each of you and your teams for your diligence in maintaining a safe and healthy workplace. We have been on a learning journey throughout this crisis, and I am pleased that the current protocols at our worksites have proven to be effective at minimizing the spread of COVID-19.

We continue to adapt as we learn more about risk areas at our sites following the outbreak at our Kaybob Duvernay operations at the end of 2020, and the introduction of new, more infectious variants of the COVID-19 virus. That's why we will add an additional step to protect the health and safety of high-risk groups.

Effective March 15, 2021, workers at a Kaybob Duvernay site in a high-risk group must complete a [Rapid COVID-19 Antigen Test](#) at the start of their rotational shift.

The workers at your company have been identified as being included in the high-risk group.

High-risk groups

As outlined in the [COVID-19 Testing Policy](#), high-risk workers are those who:

- Perform shiftwork and live at camp while working at a Kaybob Duvernay site
- Are unable to maintain two metres of physical distance from other workers and work within a cohort
- Are in close contact (within two metres) with workers described above for more than 15 minutes

Each worker who will be subject to testing will be notified by their supervisor before starting their next rotational shift. All concerns about submitting a COVID-19 Rapid

Antigen Test must be brought forward as soon as possible *before* the worker's first shift following March 15, 2021. Our ability to offer rapid tests to workers in high-risk groups at our sites keeps those who live and work in close-proximity safe, while also maintaining business continuity.
